

REDLAND ART GALLERY



Redland Art Gallery was officially opened in 2003 and is dedicated to the memory of Eddie Santagiuliana, a former Mayor of the Shire. The gallery is located east of Brisbane in Redland City, an area that covers 537 km² consisting of mainland and islands. Redland Art Gallery serves a population of 131,000 in a region of bayside suburbs, hinterland areas and islands scattered throughout Moreton Bay.

Redland Art Gallery's exhibitions and events feature local and Queensland-based artists as well as nationally and internationally recognised artists. Exhibitions are held in six exhibition spaces across two locations, Cleveland and Capalaba. Gallery programs also extend to island and other mainland locations. The gallery's policy is to present a balanced and varied exhibition program of innovative and traditional works that provide opportunities for residents and visitors to engage with the visual arts, craft and design and support representation of the Redlands' diverse culture and heritage.
